The Senior Vice President is a member of Providence College's senior management team; oversees the college's finance, accounting and treasury functions, facilities and capital projects, the division of information technology, auxiliary services and contracts, and other related areas and functions; provides leadership to the College's strategic and budget planning processes; serves as a critical liaison to the Board of Trustees; and plays a significant role in supporting the College's resource development efforts.

Providence College seeks candidates with outstanding leadership and executive skills; strong analytical ability; a collaborative and collegial management style; demonstrated success in planning, managing and stewarding resources; experience overseeing multiple financial and business functions; excellent and transparent communication skills; and ability to forge effective working relationships with a broad range of constituents. A master's degree in business or a related field is required, and a CPA is preferred. Candidates also must support and contribute to the mission of Providence College.
